a. leading edge of treads radiused/beveled			
b. uniform run/rise in any one flight			
c. no significant alteration in run/rise in successive flights			
d. maximum vertical rise of flights between floors/landings not exceeded			
e. minimum headroom clearance maintained			
f. check floor to floor heights against building sections			
2. Ramps:			
a. slopes indicated			
b. landings/level areas adjacent to doors			
3. Guards:			
a. height			
b. limited opening sizes through guards			
c. designed to prevent climbing			
d. cross-referenced to large-scale details			
4. Dimensions:			
a. tread/riser			
b. horizontal/vertical			
c. landings			
d. height of handrails/guards			
5. Large-scale details:			
a. typical tread/riser			
b. custom-fabricated items			
c. special conditions
